1802-1810 Novels - Literature in the 1800s

Charlotte Brontë - *Jane Eyre* - "Both from pitying her" "the novel"

Both novels, apparently, the term romantic doesn't mean one unrequited love and all that goes down!

Victorian Literature - Literature written while Queen Victoria was the monarch of England

Famous English Authors:
Jane Austen 1775-1817
Starts her own work: *Pride and Prejudice*, *Emma*, *Sense and Sensibility*
Published one of her most famous works: *Pride and Prejudice*, in 1813, in the Georgian era. Originally published for serials, not for the general public. It was the first of a series of novels by Austen.

We read this in class earlier in the year. It was one of the most loved by all.

Mary Shelley 1797-1840
Starts her own work: *Frankenstein*
Published *Frankenstein* in 1818, just before Victorian era. Also, she published *Frankenstein* in 1818, in the Georgian era. Originally published for serials, not for the general public. It was the first of a series of novels by Shelley.

Really loved by the monster for *Frankenstein* two years ago it was a success!

Charles Dickens 1812-1870
Starts her own work: *Oliver Twist*, *A Christmas Carol*, *Great Expectations*, *A Tale of Two Cities*, *The Pickwick Papers*
None of her works were originally published as books, but instead into serials. *Oliver Twist* - episode or serial and has been published as books. There's a common myth that Dickens's work was part of the serial which is not true.

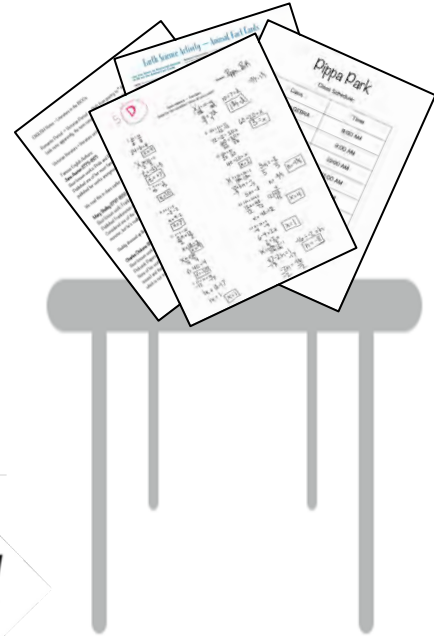
Stage Pippa's Bedroom, pt. 1



Place bookmarks in books.

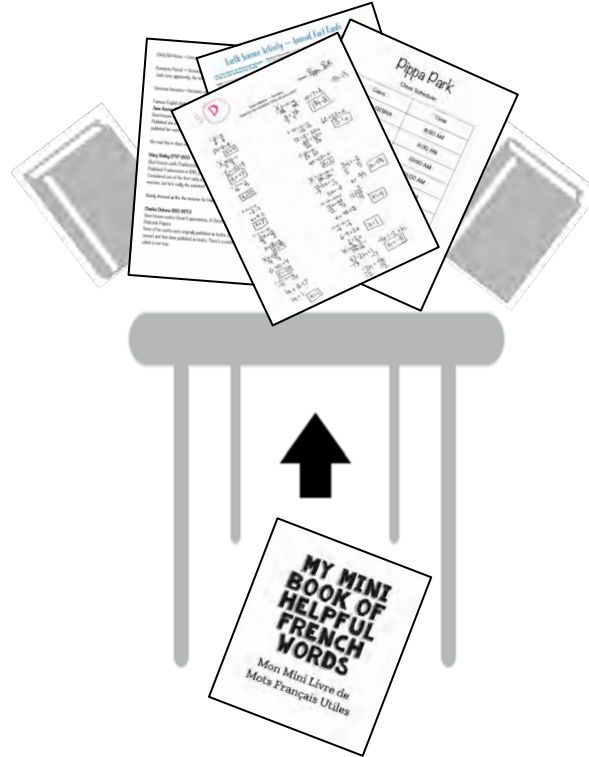
Bookmarks can go in the corresponding classics, but it is not required.

Use flowchart to walk through the clues and make sure everything is where it should be

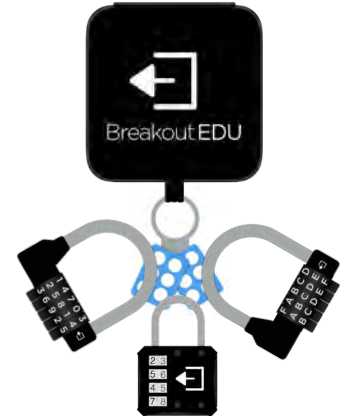
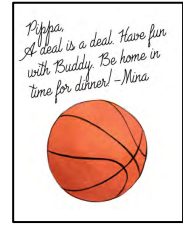
